WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY

Our college emphasizes on holistic waste management and providing a safe healthy work environment for teaching and non-teaching employees, trainees, and visitors. The college adopts the principles of "best practicable environmental option" in the delivery of waste management services. The policy of reuse, reduce and recycle is followed in our college. Proper waste management is done in our college through segregated collection, transportation and disposal of garbage, sewage and other waste products.

Solid waste management:

- To reduce waste at institute, trainees and staff are educated on proper waste management practices.
- Waste is collected on a daily basis from various sources and is separated as dry and wet waste.
- Color coded dustbins are used for different types of wastes.
- Daily garbage is collected by sweeper and disposed properly.
- Waste material like plastic, papers etc. are collected and sold out to scrap vendor from time to time.
- Efforts have been taken to produce compost manure. Composting is an easy and natural bio-degradation process that takes organic wastes i.e., remains of plants and garden and kitchen waste and turns into nutrient-rich food for our plants. We have a vermi-compost pit in the backyard of our college. In this process all the waste from the hostel kitchen and college canteen is dumped in one of the chamber of the vermi-compost pit. After a month it is transferred to the next chamber and worms are added. In the next stage worms are separated and the fine manure is applied in the garden. Manure is used for the purpose of herbal garden as well or for planted tree.
- The practice of reusing paper is one of the biggest examples of waste management in our college.
- The excess water of the hostel water tank is collected in the well and reused.

E-waste management

- The E-waste collected is stored in store room and disposed every year accordingly.
- Empty toners, cartridges, outdated computers and electronic items are sold as scrap to ensure their safe recycling.
- Old monitors and CPUs are repaired by our technician and reused.
