STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

SESSION: 2020-2022

ACADEMIC- Majority 51.64% students of the college perceive that academic needs are excellently met by the college, that teachers are approachable (67.03%), perceive that technology of teaching is used (35.16%), students perceive that quality of classroom teaching is excellent (57.14%), students perceive that student-teacher relation is excellent (73.62%). Majority of the students perceive that cultural activities (75.82%) and excursions (40.65%) organized by the college are highly satisfactory. Internship program was a good experience for 59.34% of the students. 34.06% students perceive that college provides an efficient internal evaluation system. 49.45% of the students perceive that the classroom learning environment of the VTT College is highly satisfactory.




Fig 1: Academic Dimension

TEACHER- 80.21% students agreed teachers have a good command over their subjects. About 54.94% reported communication skills of teachers are excellent and 52.74% report sincerity of the teachers are excellent. 49.45% agreed teachers were highly motivating, 29.67% felt teachers have ability to integrate course material with environment needs are excellent, 38.46% felt teachers taught in an interdisciplinary manner, 47.25% felt teachers were easily accessible inside and outside the classroom. 59.34% of students perceive that the attitude of the teachers towards extracurricular activities is excellent. 51.64% of the students perceive that ability to evaluate students understanding during teaching learning process is excellent. 41.75% of the students perceive that there is a provision of sufficient time for feedback.

ADMINISTRATIVE- 53.84% of the students perceive that office students' relationships are excellent, 46.15% of the students perceive that office related works are timely completed.




Fig 3: Administrative Dimension




Fig 4: Facilities of College

TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

SESSION:- 2020-2022

100% of teachers of VTT College perceive that curriculum is as per the need of the student, 75% of teachers feel that the contents of the course have been presented from simple to complex form, and 56% of teachers of that the curriculum provides opportunity for the conducting research and project related activities, 68.75% of teachers of that the curriculum is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge, 56.25% of teachers that the curriculum development procedures needs improvement.

87.5% of teachers perceive that the contents of the course are in conformity with the learning outcomes, 68.75% of teachers perceive that pedagogy proposed in the curriculum matches the contents, 56.25% of teachers perceive that the contents of the curriculum are in tune with the need of teaching learning process. 62.5% of teachers perceive that the opinion of the faculty members is taken into account during curriculum revision and 37.5% of teachers perceive that the presence of students' representative in the curriculum has no value. 62.5% of teachers perceive that evaluation of the course is appropriate to discriminate among the good and weak students and 87.5% of teachers feel the majority of students perceive that the evaluation system is comprehensive to assess the attainment of course objectives. 93.75% of teachers perceive that the college provides you freedom to adopt new techniques/ strategies of teaching.



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81.25% teachers perceive that the curriculum has the potential in developing the habit of self-learning among the students. 50% of teachers perceive that the learning outcomes of the curriculum are of global standard, 81.25% teachers feel the curriculum has focus on skills development.




Fig 6: Overall Teacher Feedback

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

84% of the Alumni perceive that education imparted at this institution was useful and relevant with their current job, 80% of the alumni perceive that they have obtained sufficient know- how (both in theory and practice) at this college, 92% of the alumni perceive that infrastructure and laboratories faculties of the college were excellent, 100 % of the alumni perceive that library facilities of the college were excellent, 96% of the alumni perceive that faculty of the college were very effective, 80% of the alumni perceive that curricular and co-curricular activities organized by the college contributed to their overall development, 76% of the alumni perceive that college ensure proper implementation of the curriculum, 96% of the alumni perceive that college provides counseling and guidance for placement or higher studies, 100 % of the alumni confirm that college conduct excursion and extension work, 96% of the alumni perceive that college invites practice teaching schools to collaborate in curriculum development, 84% of the alumni perceive that college invite community members to collaborate in curriculum

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improvement, 92% of the alumni perceive that he/she has been invited to deliver a guest lecture / special talk/ motivational session for their juniors, Majority of the alumni confirm that they have participated in any alumni meet of the college and they receive communications from the college through mail, call or sms and they feel proud to be associated with the college as an alumni, view the college in positive light.




Fig 7: Overall Alumni Feedback

PRACTICE TEACHING SCHOOL FEEDBACK ANALYSIS SESSION:- 2020-2022

100% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that the training college invites them to participate in meeting related to practice teaching, 90% the Head of the Institutions perceive that they feel the period for practice teaching for trainee teachers is adequate to make them effective teachers, 80% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that they think the practice teaching is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge and that 90% feel the present two year B.Ed. curriculum is effective in developing content specific skills and transaction skills required in classroom, 90% think simulated teaching is sufficient before trainee teachers teach a real class, only 10% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that the trainee teachers are not competent enough to handle their classes, 90% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that teaching aids used by trainee teachers are effective, and 80% that teaching by teacher trainees help in completing their syllabus effectively while 20% believed they can't, 70% the Head of the Institutions perceive that they observe the classes of teacher trainees every day and 90%



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confirm that their students are satisfied with the teaching of teacher trainees while 10% were undecided, 90% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that trainee teachers possess good communication skills while 10% were undecided, 90% the Head of the Institutions perceive that trainee teachers are able to establish healthy rapport with their students while 10% were undecided, 90% the Head of the Institutions perceive that trainee teachers are efficient in school management while 10% were undecided, 80% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that they find the present two year B.Ed. curriculum comprehensive and disagree while 20%, 30% the Head of the Institutions perceive that they feel the B.Ed. curriculum lacks emphasis on children with special needs while 20% were undecided, 90% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that they think the B.Ed. curriculum helps in personality development of trainee teachers, 90% of the Head of the Institutions perceive that the trainee teachers build good rapport with concerned subject teachers while 10% were undecided, 90% of Head of the Institutions confirm that the trainee teachers observe classes of specific subject teachers and 90% of Head of the Institutions confirm that the mentors of training college visit school regularly for supervision of classes of teacher trainees.




Fig 8: Feedback of Practice Teaching School Headmasters



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
