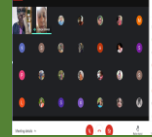
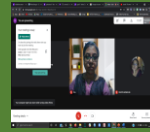
#### INDEPENDENCE DAY

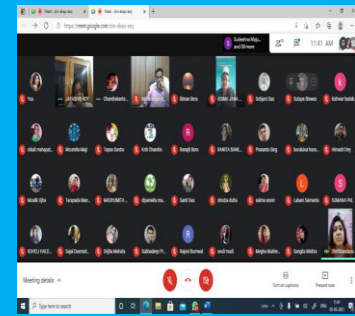
#### VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK

#### REPUBLIC DAY

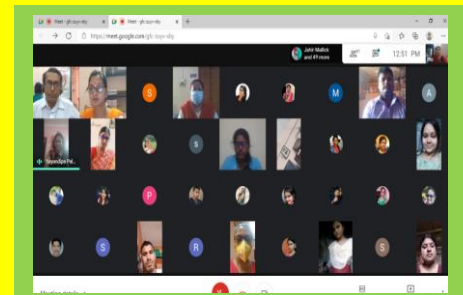
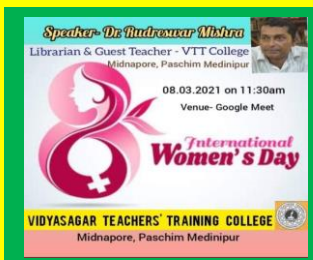

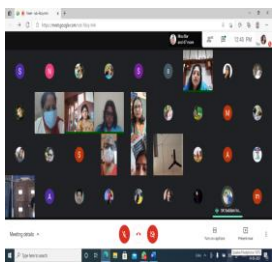


#### INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

## CBSE CURRICULUM AND ASSESSMENT"

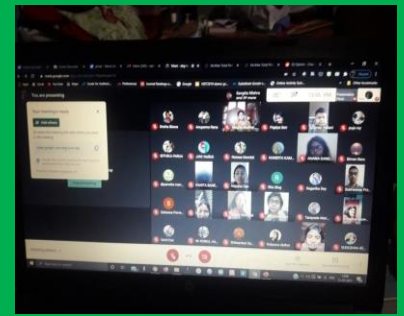

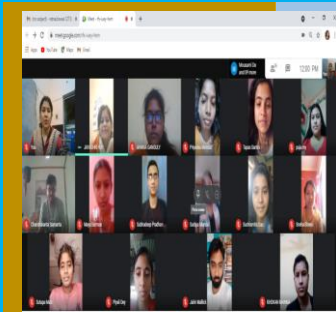

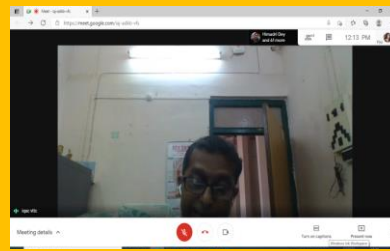
## WORLD METEOROLOGICAL DAY

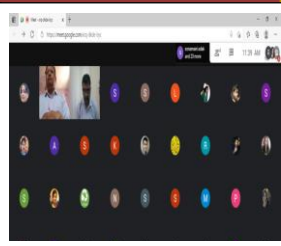

## WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY

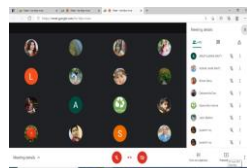

## MOTHERS' DAY



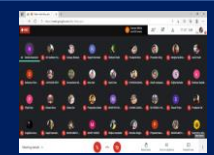

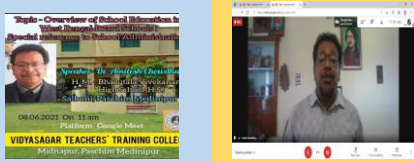
## WORLD COMMONWEALTH DAY

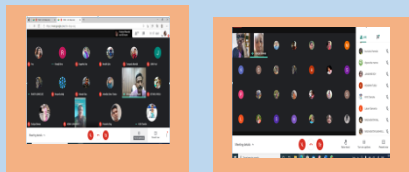


## OVERVIEW OF SCHOOL EDUCATION IN WEST BENGAL BOARD SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

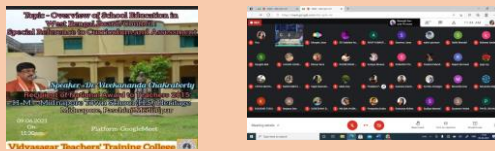

## ALUMNI MEET



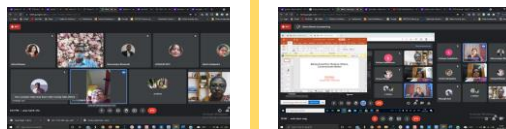

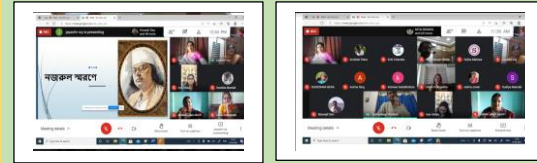

## NAZRUL JAYANTI



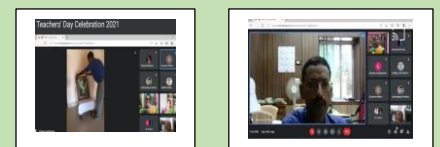
Our college celebrated the birth anniversary of Kazi Nazrul Islam with full honours. A cultural function held on 12.06.2021.

## INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

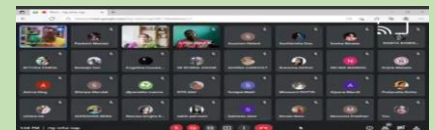
