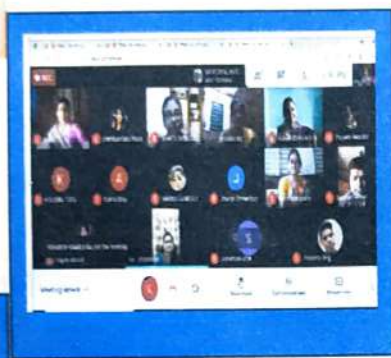
Lecture on "School Curriculum and Assessment process of schools/ under WB board and council"

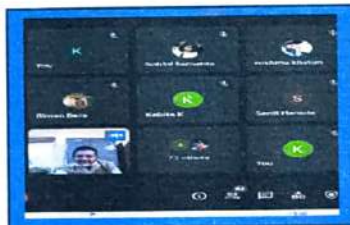


Independence Day

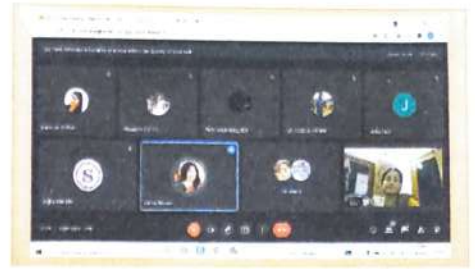

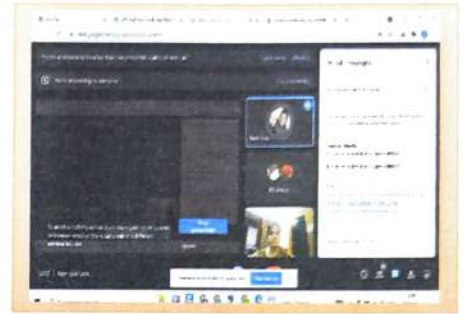
Virtual Interaction Day

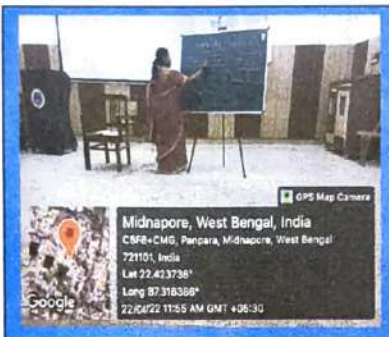
Special Class on Effective Communications

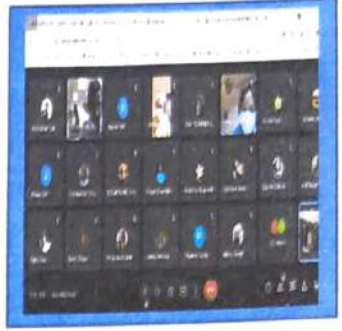

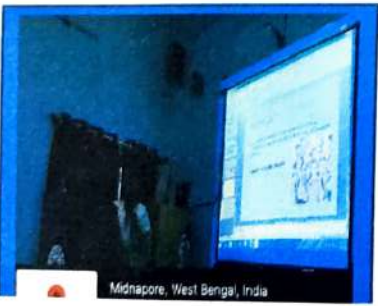
Special Class on Microteaching



NEP Lecture :1

Principal Sir spoke to students about the importance of NEP and why every teacher should become aware about its recommendations. The speech ended with vote of thanks from the anchor. After this the speaker of the day Dr. Ranita Banerjee was introduced to give her talk. She started with the structure of school education (5+3+3+1) as suggested by NEP 2020. For the very first time pre-primary education was given real importance in any educational policy. Over 85% of a child's cumulative learning development occurs prior to the age of 6, which requires ECCE to be available to every young children, particularly children from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds. Universal provisioning of quality early childhood development, care, and education must thus be achieved as soon as possible, and no later than 2030, to ensure that all students entering Grade 1 are school ready. Dr. Banerjee also stated ECCE ideally consists of flexible, multi-faceted, multi-level, play-based, activity-based, and inquiry-based learning, comprising of alphabets, languages, numbers, counting, colours, shapes, indoor and outdoor play, puzzles and logical thinking, problem-solving, drawing, painting and other visual art, craft, drama and puppetry, music and movement.

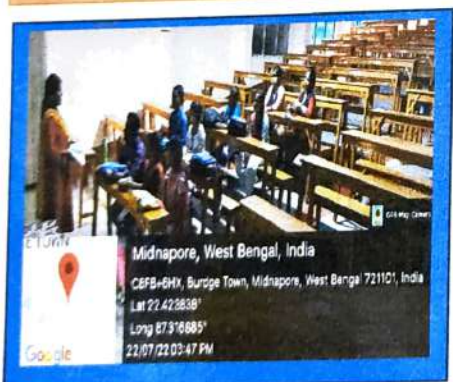
