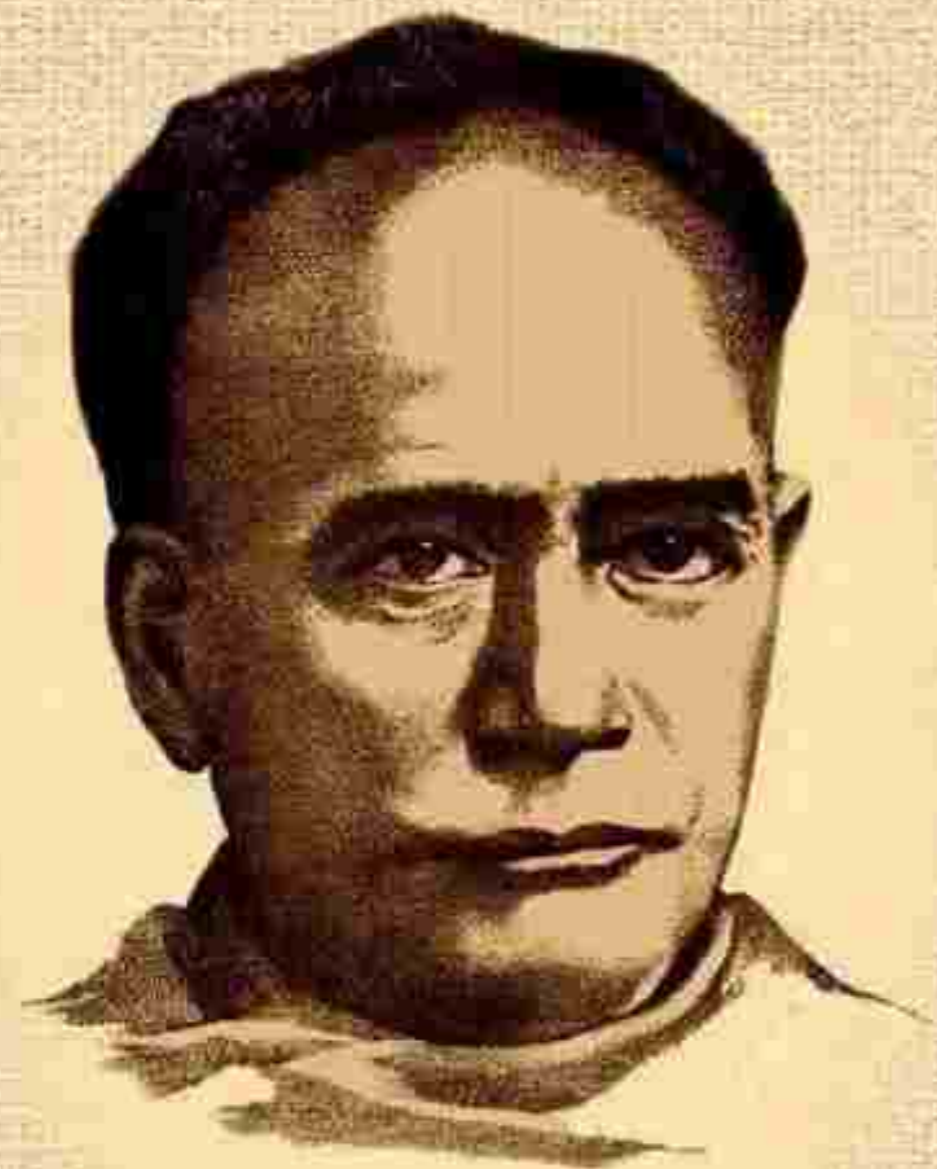

Special Class on Bloom's Taxonomy (23.12.2022)

A special class on Bloom's Taxonomy was held on 23.12.2022 where students of 7th semester participated. The session was started by Dr. Jayashri Roy (Teacher Council Secretary) who introduced the speaker. The speaker of this session was Dr. Ranita Banerjee who commenced the talk with importance of Bloom's Taxonomy in B.Ed. program. She started her lecture with older version of Bloom's Taxonomy and elaborated about the parts of Cognitive dimension in the older version. She then moved to the revised version where there are two dimensions- Cognitive and Knowledge. She stated that there are six levels of cognitive learning-remembering, understanding, applying, analysis, evaluation and creating. The cognitive process dimension is actually a continuum where the cognitive complexity increases from retention/recall. She added there are four types of knowledge under the knowledge dimension which ranges from concrete (factual knowledge) to abstract (meta-cognitive knowledge). After teaching the framework theoretically she gave examples from various subjects and topics. She also asked the students to prepare some learning objectives based on Revised Bloom's Taxonomy. Finally, students asked their queries and were given responses. The session ended with Dr. Jayashri Roy (Teacher Council Secretary) giving vote of thanks to Principal and speaker.



Seminar Lecture on Community Based Activities (24.12.2022)

Community-based activities play a huge role in the learning and skills development of students at Focus Beyond. These activities include work-based learning, community awareness, and independent living activities. A special lecture on 'Community-based activities' was organized by Vidyasagar teachers' training college, Midnapore on 24.12.2022 at 10 A.M to 12 P.M. It is very much essential to create a social awareness among the trainees to keep themselves clean and maintain proper hygiene. The speaker of the first session was Dr. Jayashri Roy who commenced the talk with importance of Community Based Activities in B.Ed. program. A Seminar on "Achievement Test and Rating Scale" was held on 22.12.2022 for upgrade trainee teachers for there to communicate more effectively at work and achieve their goals. The test challenges students to use their higher-order thinking skills to create a product or complete a process. The speaker of day was Dr. Kishwar Badakhshan and Dr. Jayasri Roy, Asst. Prof. of this college. The programme was held between 11 AM to 3PM.



Special Class on Pedagogical Approaches and Effective Teaching Learning (23.12.2022)

A Special Class focused on Innovative Pedagogical Approaches and Effective Teaching Learning was organized by Vidyanagar Teachers' Training College on 23.12.2022 at 2 P.M to 3 P.M. The speaker of this session was Dr. Sarapa Biswas who commenced the talk with importance of teaching new technologies are adapting to bring change in existing system for fulfilment of predetermined educational objectives. Earlier books were only source of instruction, individualized learning and individualized teaching. Finally, students asked their queries and were given responses.



Field visit Guidance and Counselling Narayan Vidyabhawan for Boys (08.07.2022)

Guidance and counselling is the process of helping individuals discover and develop their educational, vocational, and psychological strengths and lead to a path of personal happiness and social usefulness. Guidance is advice on general psychological problems and is given by someone more qualified or experienced. Counselling is a professional advice for individuals' personal or psychological problems. The B.Ed. curriculum has an optional paper devoted to Guidance and Counselling (1.4.1) under which trainees visited to Colotelgola Sri Narayan Vidyabhawan Boys High School Midnapore, West Bengal on 08.07.2022. The trainees were supervised by Dr. Sujit Samanta, Dr. Manita Banerjee and Ratna Biswas of this institution. 30 trainees undertook the case study and half of them surveyed children for phobia and other 15 trainees surveyed children for Anxiety. The trainees prepared questionnaire of 20 items each to measure Anxiety/ Phobia.



Aranya Saptaha Celebration (14.07.2022-20.07.2022)

Our college celebrated Aranya Saptaha this year from 14.07.2022-20.07.2022. The main objective of Aranya Saptaha Palar is to beautify our Earth's environment through these activities. The ceremony is held for seven days. On the first day, our Principal sir give welcome speech and handed over trees to the students and started the program by planting some trees on the campus. The next day saplings were distributed in the locality. The residents are made environment conscious by planting trees and distributing saplings. The last day of the Aranya Saptaha ended with a cultural program.



Visit to Special School - Midnapore Rehabilitation Centre for Children (16.07.2022)

Disability is one of the most serious education related barriers which affects children in every nation. Inclusive education allows all students whether normal or disabled to be part of formal education. Inclusive schools are platforms which closes the gap between special and normal children. The B.Ed. curriculum has an entire paper devoted to Inclusive education (I.A.10) under which trainees visited to Midnapore Rehabilitation Centre for children on 16.07.2022. The trainees were supervised by Dr. Kaibhwar Badakhshan and Dr. Ranita Banerjee of this institution. This school had children who are visually impaired, hearing impaired and mentally retarded. The trainees visited the inclusive classroom and observed how the teachers are teaching them. Trainees also visited the Resource Room which hoarded tons of teaching equipments. The inclusive school teachers showed the trainees how each equipment worked. Trainees also visited the library which contained useful books for special children. The trainees were given a campus tour to become acquainted with the infrastructure of Inclusive schools.



Student of the Year - 2022 (20.07.2022)

The criterion for the award is based on the performance of student in studies, extracurricular activities, attendance, punctuality and participation in college activities. Based on the evaluation by our Principal and faculty members, the best student is selected and awarded on the last day of Aranyu Saptaha Celebration. This year award was given to Soumen Hiran as the best student of the year-2022.



Mentor-Mentee Meet (21.12.2022)



Apart from the mentoring sessions conducted on 21.12.2022 at 4 pm for all the mentees in general, individual mentoring was also given to mentees who were identified as slow learners and advanced learners. The performance of some of the mentees was below the average level of performance of the whole class. The mentoring sessions helped to identify the cause of the poor performance and the mentees were helped to overcome their learning difficulties after a few personal mentoring sessions. Mentoring sessions were planned to motivate the mentees positively, to believe in their potential, do their best and adapt to the changing circumstances.





Workshop on Geography and Physical Science (14.12.2022-15.12.2022)

A workshop was organized by the Department of Geography in collaboration with IQAC on 14.12.2022 and 15.12.2022 coordinated by Dr. Jayashri Roy on the topic "Hands on Practice for Young Learners of Geography". The purpose of this workshop was to create a healthy and purposeful learning environment for the learners of Geography. A total of 48 students from Chaitanyabati High School and Nirmal Hriday Girls High School participated in this two days' workshop. The students were from grade IX to XI of West Bengal Board Schools. 11 miniresearchers of Geography helped the students to perform different practicals. Two delegates (Headmistress of Chaitanyabati High School and Sangeeta Barman, Asst. Teacher of Nirmal Hriday Girls' High School) and Dr. Nilay Kumar Barman Resource Person, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Geography, Midnapore Azamgarh College helped in co-ordinating different activities of this programme. Dr. Jayashri Roy, Asst. Professor in Geography was the co-coordinator of this workshop. The following activities were carried out:

A workshop was organized by the Department of Physical Science in collaboration with IQAC on 14.12.2022 and 15.12.2022, coordinated by Dr. Biswajit Sen and Dr. Sujit Sarma on the topic "Hands on Experiments to teach Physical Science". The purpose of this workshop was to create a healthy and purposeful learning environment for the young learners of Physical Science. A total of 22 students from Kurlita High School participated in this two days' workshop. The students were from grade IX to XI of West Bengal Board Schools.

A large number of students as well as teachers participated in the seminar. Dr. Biswajit Sen, delivered a comprehensive lecture on various Skills of Micro Teaching, which was followed by an extensive and effective interactive session.



NEP Lecture (28.07.2022)

NEP 2020: Early Childhood Care and Education, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy and Dropout Rates. Childhood Care and Education was the topic of lecture given by Dr. Ranita Banerjee on 28.07.2022. The speaker of the day talked about the structure of school education (5+3+3+4) as suggested by NEP 2020. In the schooling system, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy refers to education of a child between 3-8 years of age. This essentially includes the initial three years of pre-school, followed by early primary education up to grade 2, as per the National Education Policy (NEP 2020).



Vidyasagar's Death Anniversary (29.07.2022)

Vidyasagar's death anniversary is celebrated in our college on 29.07.2022 at 2 PM. A cultural program was organized where students performed songs, dances and plays. NEP Lecture (29.07.2022)

NEP 2020: Teacher Development, Accreditation and Equity by Dr. Kishwar Badakhshan on 29.07.2022 at 11 AM. A special lecture series on NEP 2020 was held. The speaker emphasized on concept of NEP 2020 regarding schools to deal with a shortage of teachers by sharing teachers across campuses, especially for disciplines such as art, craft, music, and dance. The NEP 2020 also recommends strengthening the recruitment process by including a live teacher demonstration and re-evaluating the test material for Teacher Eligibility Tests (TETs) for content, pedagogy, and all stages of student learning foundational, preparatory, middle, and secondary.



Workshop on Microteaching (02.08.2022-04.08.2022)

Three Days' workshop on Micro Teaching was held on 02.08.2022-04.08.2022 in our college. All the students of 2nd Semester as well as teachers of every method participated the workshop. Dr. Monoranjan Bhowmik, Principal, and all faculties of the college attended in the workshop. They delivered a comprehensive lecture on various Skills of Micro Teaching, which was followed by an extensive and effective interactive session and practice of microteaching skills.

Our institution believes aptitude with average merit has far better potential than one with merit but without aptitude.

Session 11 (1.45 p.m. -2.30 p.m) The last session on Our College Library: A Learning Resource Centre by Dr. Rudraswar Mishra (Librarian) who gave a detailed outline of the available library facilities. He also explained the new additions to our library, lending procedure and importance of library in this institution.

Session 12 (11.10 pm-1.10 pm) The feedback of the entire program was collected from trainees using a feedback form with the purpose to improve and modify future induction programs. There was a small briefing about the various cells and committees in the college. The entire session was conducted under the leadership of Dr. Jayashri Roy.
