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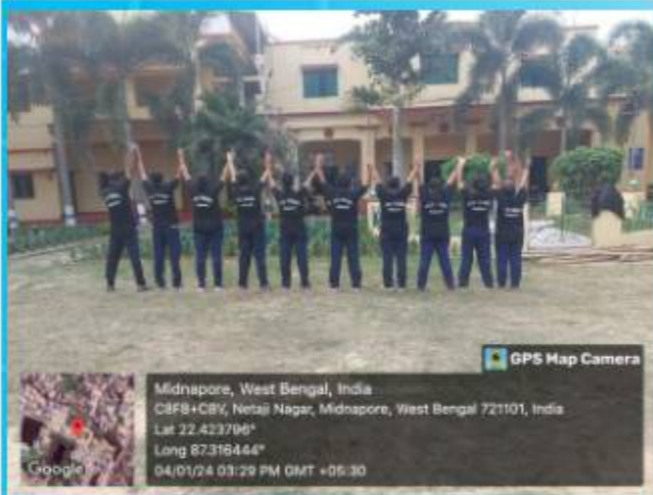
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Activities of NSS (04.01.2024)

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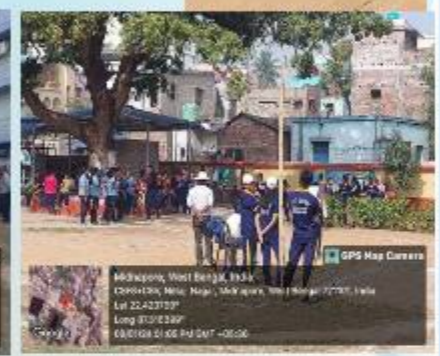
Visit Botanical Garden : 3rd Sem Life Science method (06.01.2024)

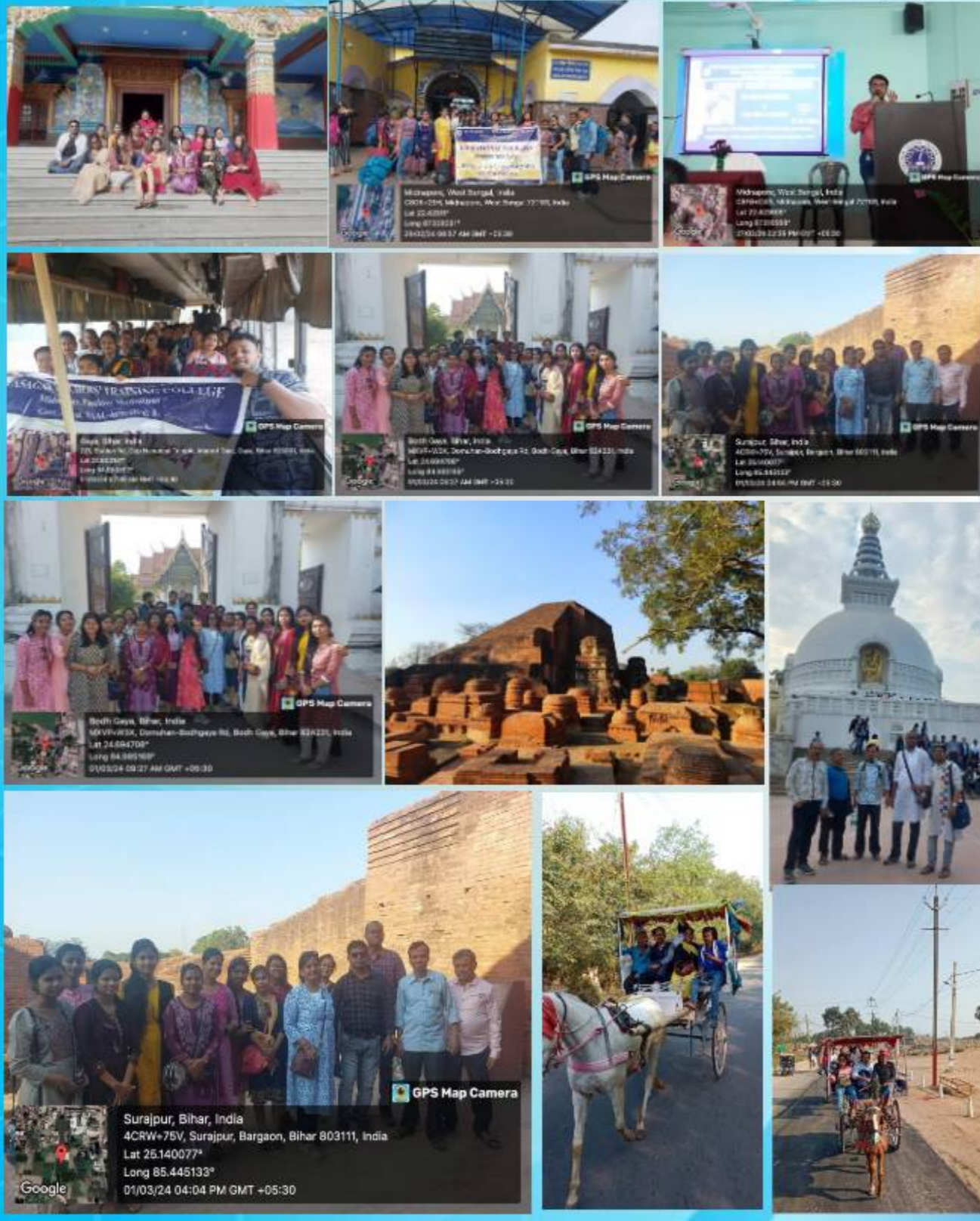
Book Discussion (27.02.2024)

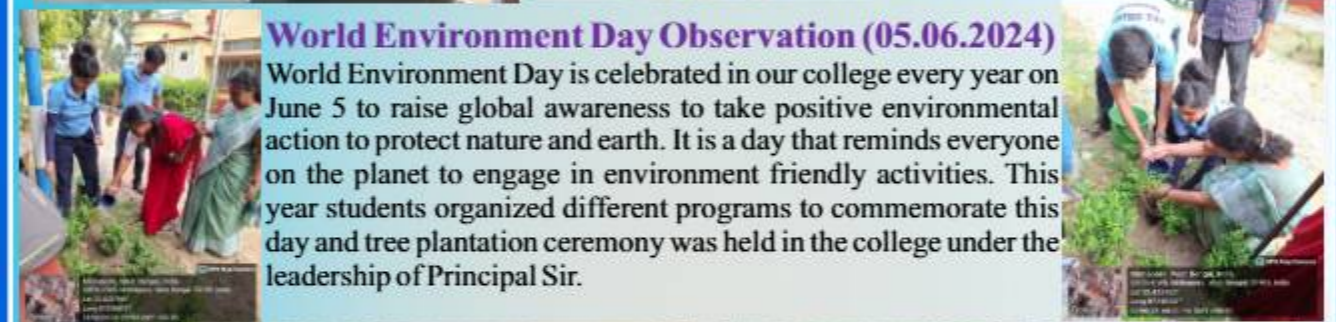
Rabindra Jayanti Palan (09.05.2024)
